Through this policy, the Corporation of the Town of Cochrane commits to:

- The provision of safe drinking water
- Continual improvement of the QMS and the water works
- Complying with relevant legislation and regulations

We strive to achieve these goals and adhere to the commitments above through the implementation of a management system comprised of policies, procedures, instructions, and forms that demonstrate risk-based treatment process evaluation, staff competency, open communications, workplace safety, and appropriate contingency/incident response measures.

The managers and employees of the Town of Cochrane who are directly involved in the supply of drinking water, share in the responsibilities of implementing, maintaining, and contributing to the continual improvement of the Quality Management System.

This policy shall serve as the foundation of our drinking water quality management system. It will be communicated to all employees through orientation sessions (QMS and New Hire), internal postings, memos and meetings. It will be communicated to the public through posting of the policy in public areas of the Town Hall as well as the Water and Wastewater Office and the Town of Cochrane web-site and through occasional mailings of flyers and handouts.
