

Holiday Family Photos

- Book an appointment in advance, if possible.
- Self-screen before attending; if unwell, visit at a later date.
- Practice physical distancing from other families, the photographer and anyone else present.
- Consider visiting the photographer with members from your immediate household only.
- Bring hand sanitizer and wash your hands often.
- A face covering or mask is required at all times in indoor public spaces (this includes during the photos).
- Face masks are required indoors and outdoors when you are unable to maintain a distance of 2 metres from people you do not live with (this includes during the photos).
- Request photos be sent through email.
- Wash and sanitize your hands often.
- Follow cough and sneeze etiquette.
- Avoid touching your eyes, mouth, and nose.

As a photographer or volunteer, remember to follow the proven public health measures as well to stay safe:

- Ensure that all employees complete the COVID-19 self-assessment before the photo session.
- Anyone with symptoms, even mild, should stay home, self-isolate and call their local COVID-19 Assessment Center.
- Have hand sanitizer available.
- Disinfect commonly touched surfaces (i.e., *where families sit for photos*)
- Consider contactless methods of payment
- Have photos emailed rather than printed in person.
- Keep a record of your customers. Collect as many details as possible (i.e., *names of all those within a family who attend.*)
